

## What is Glaucoma ?

A condition of increased pressure within the eyeball, causing gradual loss of sight.

Seeing halos around lights



**Peripheral** vision loss



Redness in the eve



**Blurred** vision



Shooting pain in eye with nausea or vomiting

The signs of increased eye pressure may not be cleasr. Parents should look for these symptoms:

- Cloudy, unusally large eyes/eye
- Eyes sensitive to sunlight or camera flashes
- Excessive tearing
- Difficulty adjusting in the dark
- Red eyes



With these signs of glaucoma, get your child examined by a pediatric eye doctor/ophthalmologits.
